

### Budget Comparison (in millions)





# How Will the Funds Be Spent? Top-Four Priorities:

- 1. Enhance team performance hire and retain the best personnel, improve facilities and equipment \$4.0 million
- 2. Improve support for student-athletes (academics, apparel, training) \$2.0 million
- 3. Increase recruiting budget \$700,000
- 4. Enhance team travel \$3.0 million
