The University of Hawaii Foundation is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) contracted by the University of Hawaii Board of Regents to be the sole provider of alumni services and fundraising for the UH System. The funds we raise are critical for supporting the educational mission of UH, one of the largest drivers of Hawaii's economy. This private support funds scholarships to build Hawaii's future workforce, helps attract top faculty talent, and fuels world-class research.

Our mission is to unite donors' passions with the University of Hawaii's aspirations by raising philanthropic support and managing private investments to benefit UH, the people of Hawaii and our future generations.

How our work makes an impact

- We employ a team of professionals, organized to serve donors and alumni, with expertise in major gifts, foundation and corporate giving, annual giving, and tax and planned giving to help donors meet their philanthropic goals.
- We partner with chancellors, deans and academic leaders across the UH System to identify strategic opportunities that align with current and prospective donors' passions.
- We manage an endowment of more than \$641.9 million that distributes \$20 million in student aid to students across 10 UH System campuses each year.
- We fund a variety of community enrichment and lifelong learning programs, including athletics and the arts.
- We nurture relationships with nearly 350,000 UH alumni around the world to build pride and connect them to their alma mater.

What we do

Development

Guided by the strategic direction of the University of Hawai'i and its 10 campuses, our development professionals at the UH Foundation raise private funds to support UH students, programs, faculty and research. Departments that work directly with our donors include:

DEVELOPMENT TEAMS

Our campus and unit Development teams collaborate with University of Hawai'i academic leaders to raise philanthropic gifts that support the priorities of all 10 UH campuses. These teams foster meaningful, often lifelong, relationships on behalf of the university with donors and prospective donors who believe in partnering with UH for far-reaching impact for Hawai'i and beyond.

STUDENT AID

In addition to raising funds to directly support students on their academic journey via student aid and scholarships, our Scholarship team distributes \$20 million in student aid each year. By working with the campus financial aid offices and hosting an online search engine for privately funded scholarships, students on campuses statewide receive essential financial support they need to succeed.

ANNUAL GIVING

Our Annual Giving team reaches out to UH graduates, parents and friends of the university year-round through online, direct mail and telephone campaigns to raise funds. We have an on-site calling center that employs student fundraisers who help us contact all UH alumni at least once per year.

ESTATE & GIFT PLANNING

Our Estate & Gift Planning team partners with donors, their families, and professional advisors to design thoughtful gifts that reflect each donor's values and philanthropic goals. The team provides expertise in structuring complex gifts, such as bequests, charitable trusts, real estate, retirement assets, and life insurance, to help donors create lasting impact across UH. Working closely with development officers and campus leaders, the team also supports fundraising efforts systemwide by integrating charitable gift planning strategies into initiatives and identifying opportunities for blended and planned gifts.

CORPORATE & FOUNDATION RELATIONS

Our Corporate & Foundation Relations team works with faculty and academic leaders along with corporate and foundation donors to support faculty research and scholarship; student support and community outreach.

Donor Relations

Our Donor Relations team represents the interests of University of Hawai'i Foundation donors to all 10 UH campuses and builds a culture of stewardship throughout the UH community.

Alumni Relations

Our Alumni Relations team works closely with campus leaders to reach nearly 350,000 UH alumni and engage them around UH student recruitment, retention, career services, advocacy and mentorship. They celebrate alumni achievements to build pride and connection with UH in meaningful and relevant ways. They also facilitate lifelong learning opportunities.

Investment Management

We manage an endowment of more than \$641.9 million – and growing – that distributes \$20 million in student aid to students across 10 UH System campuses each year. Generous gifts from donors and a disciplined focus on investment strategies and opportunities help the endowment grow over the long term, so it can provide support for UH programs and priorities into the future.

Accounting & Finance

Our Accounting & Finance team administers and manages funds from donor gifts to benefit units and campuses throughout the UH System. They work to establish new accounts and maintain nearly 8,000 separate donor accounts. They're also able to process gifts in a variety of ways – from checks, credit cards and cash to gifts of real estate, stocks, bonds and more.

Special Events

Our Special Events team provides donors with meaningful opportunities to engage with UH leadership, faculty and students.
